The icebreaker name and winners of the competition will be publicly announced in September 2017, with the prize flight taking place in November or December 2017, on a date to be advised.

Entry format

Entries should nominate a name for the new icebreaker, and provide a rationale with reference to the [competition criteria](#).

There are two entry formats:

- A written entry (maximum 300 words); OR
- A video entry (up to 90 seconds, with transcript).

Entries must be students' own work. All entries will be assessed in the same judging process against the same criteria.

Only one entry per class or registered learning unit will be accepted. If multiple different entries are received from the same class or registered learning unit, all entries will be declared ineligible.
