Dear Parents/Caregivers

This year, Norwood Morialta HS is entering teams into the Cancer Council Relay for Life. Relay for Life is a chance for communities to recognise and celebrate those who have overcome cancer or are undergoing treatment, as well as the people who care for them. Relay also provides an opportunity to celebrate the memory of loved ones lost to cancer.

Your young person has expressed interest in participating in this event in 2017.

Teams will work together to keep a baton continuously circling the track for 20 hours. Students will take shifts and camp overnight at Bonython Park. During the event, they will also have access to events, concerts and a candlelit ceremony. Students will be representing NMHS and under the supervision and guidance of NMHS and Cancer Council staff at all times.

In preparation for this event, students commit and are encouraged to fundraise for the Cancer Council, working towards a goal of raising \$100 each towards our larger school goal. We encourage students to fundraise externally, utilising their personal networks and manage this using their online fundraising portal. They will also be required to attend meetings at school in preparation for the event.

What to know:

- Event:** Relay for Life 2017 - Central Adelaide
Date: Saturday 6th May 1:00pm - Sunday 7th May 9:00am
Location: Bonython Park
Cost: \$20 (to be paid to the Cancer Council- Instructions will be given once students have returned forms). This includes entrance to the event, breakfast, t-shirt and access to events and concerts.
Transport: It is recommended that students make their own way down and back from Bonython Park.

Upon receipt of consent and medical forms, your young person will be given instructions on how to sign-up to the Norwood Morialta High School team on the Cancer Council website and can start their fundraising.
