**Re - Street Smart High – Thursday 6 April 2017**

On Thursday 6 April our Year 10 students will take part in Street Smart High, held at the Entertainment Centre on Port Road, an initiative sponsored by the RAA. Its aim is to promote greater road safety awareness among our young drivers and soon-to-be drivers. The day will start at 9.30am and finish at 2.00pm.

**Transport**

Students are to make their own transport arrangements to the venue and should plan to arrive no later than 9.15am. Students will meet with their Personal Learning Group teacher for a roll call near the Southern Car Park of the Entertainment Centre (along Port Road).

**Uniform**

Students are required to be in **correct full school uniform**.

**Lunch**

Catering is not provided; therefore, all students will need to bring their own packed lunch including a drink. For the safety of all students attending, no one will be permitted to leave the Entertainment Centre to purchase their lunch.

**Lunchtime displays**

More than 20 agencies are providing interactive displays within the Entertainment Centre for students to visit during the lunch break. Students will be encouraged to explore their own interests and ask questions of the exhibitors.

**Warning**

RAA Street Smart High will feature a realistic crash scene re-enactment involving vehicles, emergency services and actors. The aim of this re-enactment is to be as close as possible to a real life crash. It is not designed to shock, but to realistically portray the events of a fatal car crash. Counsellors will be available to help students who find the topics explored too confronting or if they bring back memories of loved ones who have been involved in a car crash. If you believe your child may find the experience upsetting, please contact the school.

**Dismissal**
