Re: Physical Education Expectations

The Health & Physical Education Team at Norwood Morialta High is committed to supporting students to achieve success. In H&PE we promote the values of distinction, diversity and respect and we require all students to demonstrate these values in their engagement, attendance and achievement. Students need to demonstrate skills, knowledge and the capacity to engage in the curriculum effectively and use resources safely and as instructed.

To support students to achieve success the following expectations have been communicated:

1. Students are expected to actively participate in all lessons. In the event of injury, illness or circumstances that prohibit participation, a note from home that clearly explains the reason(s) and is signed by a parent or caregiver is required. *Extended injury or illness needs to be supported with a doctor's certificate.*
2. Mobile phones, portable media players and/or earphones are NOT to be brought to H&PE. Consistent with school procedures, *"Students using mobile phones in the classroom will have the phone confiscated and stored in Student Services until the end of the day".*
3. School bags must remain in student lockers. Change of clothing should be carried to lessons in the NMHS string bag (available at the uniform shop).
4. Students are expected to meet assessment deadlines. Failure to meet deadlines will result in the student being issued with after school detention and/ or sent to Student Support Room for work completion, as outlined in the school's assessment guidelines.
5. Students are required to wear the school approved PE uniform to all lessons.

 - Plain Navy Shorts
 - School hat (terms 1 & 4)
 - Lace up sports shoes.

Parent support and student commitment to the learning and safe practice expectations outlined in this letter will support students to achieve MYP and SACE success. We look forward to sharing student achievement as the year progresses.
