

Norwood Morialta High School Uniform Guidelines

Norwood Morialta High School takes great pride in its uniform and expects students to wear the correct uniform at all times. The wearing of the school uniform creates a sense of identity within our school community and assists us in managing the ongoing well-being and safety of our students.

We remind parents/caregivers and students on choosing this school that they undertake to support the school in its expectation that all students will wear the correct school uniform items listed below. Their appearance is to be neat, clean and worn in a conventional manner at all times. The wearing of other garments will be seen as incorrect uniform and therefore unacceptable.

Please note:

During 2018-2021 Norwood Morialta High School will be implementing a new school uniform. All new students commencing school from 2018 will be required to wear all items from the new school uniform collection. Continuing students may wear a combination of the newer and older style uniform pieces.

COMPULSORY ITEMS

Some uniform items are compulsory. They are worn every day and comprise the official formal uniform required for assemblies, excursions and designated occasions. Other items are optional and are not to be worn on formal occasions.

School Skirt	pleated check design (knee length)
School Pants	grey regulation uniform type
School Trousers	grey regulation uniform type
School Blouse	striped, short or long sleeved, logo on pocket
School Shirt	striped, short or long sleeved, logo on pocket
School Jumper	navy with grey stripe on V neck and school logo on left side
School Socks	grey or navy (long or short crew) not anklets or sockettes
School Tights	plain navy (not to be worn with socks or under shorts)
School Shoes	black hard leather or leather look school shoes covering the foot (Heels, boots, sneakers, canvas shoes, slip-ons are not permitted.)
School Tie	worn with shirt

OPTIONAL ITEMS

These items are not to be worn on formal occasions.

School Dress	school check design (knee length)
School Shorts	grey regulation uniform type
School Polo Shirt	short sleeve with logo – Middle School only
School Jacket	classic zip jacket with logo
School Scarf	navy with logo

School Blazer	navy, with logo and grey piping

PE Uniform

These items are to be worn for PE lessons and sport.
Students are not wear their PE uniform to and from school.

Polo Shirt	tri-colour with school logo
Shorts or Skirt	navy
Track pants	navy
Sports Shoes	with non-marking soles and socks - white
Hats	school cap or bucket hat with logo

GENERAL RULES:

Jewellery

Students are permitted to have a single piercing in each ear only with a simple stud or sleeper and NO other visible piercings

Finger rings —**one only**

No visible necklaces are to be worn

Bracelets are not permitted (Medic-Alert is the exception)

Presentation

No visible make-up is to be worn.

Fingernails are not to be painted, but may have a clear finish.

Hair is to be in a neat clean hairstyle and not dyed any colour that does not occur naturally.

Necessary school hair accessories - must be plain navy, or yellow, or red.

Facial hair which is neat and trimmed is permitted.

The wearing of any additional visible top under the school uniform is not permitted.
