RE: Week 9 Program - UPDATE

An exciting program offering a range of interesting and engaging activities will involve Year 8 and 9 students during Week 9 Term 4. The program provides students with opportunities to continue to develop their relationships and celebrate the end of the school year. All students will also participate in a half-day transition to the Senior Campus to familiarise themselves with their new campus.

Due to the range of activities and the costs involved, we are giving families advance notice to give all students the opportunity to enjoy these experiences with their peers. The day will start at 8.45am and will finish between 1.30pm -2.30pm each day other than Friday when we will finish at 11.30am. Students will be dismissed upon their return to school from their external activities. Specific details for return times for each day will be communicated closer to the date.

Monday to Wednesday there are external school activities including Waterworld, AFL Max **OR** Cleland Wildlife Park and a movie at Palace Nova Prospect. **If for any reason students are unable to attend the external program, we are able to provide supervision at school. Please register for this through the Trybooking link below.** Thursday will be teacher delivered activities on the Middle Campus and Friday will be a range of choice activities for students. These will be determined by teachers' expertise in activities and what they would like to deliver. As students are under compulsion, the **Week 9 Program is mandatory for students in Year 8 and 9.** Any students not attending will need to complete an 'Exemption Form' available from Student Services which will then need to be approved by the Principal and forwarded to the Department for Education.

Students are **not required to wear school uniform Monday to Friday**; however, we do ask that appropriate clothing is worn. Students have been consulted and we are encouraging them to begin saving for the activities. Please complete the consent and swimming consent form that has been given to your student or located in Parent Portal and return to your **PLG Teacher by Wednesday Week 5, Term 4.**

Please note: the swimming consent is required for Waterworld. If written consent is not given, the student will not participate in swimming. Verbal consent will not be approved.


