RE: Healthy Development Adelaide Student Scholarship

Schools have been invited to nominate current year 10 students for the 2022-2023 Healthy Development Adelaide (HDA) Student Scholarship. The scholarships are open for application from those who meet the following eligibility criteria:

1. be enrolled in Year 11 from 2022 and wants to proceed to tertiary education in a field relevant to health or education;
2. the applicant or their parent/caregiver is supported by means of a Health Care or Pension Concession Card and qualifies for School Card concession or equivalent.

Our records indicate that your student may be eligible to apply for this scholarship, and we encourage you to do so.

The scholarship will be for \$1000 per student provided over a two-year period contingent upon continued partner funding provided to Healthy Development Adelaide. Two hundred and fifty dollars will be made available when the student commences Year 11 in 2022. A further \$250 will be made available every 6 months to a total of two years provided that the student demonstrates a commitment to their continuing education by achieving 80% school attendance and a satisfactory progress report from their school.

As part of the HDA Student Scholarship Program, successful recipients will also receive:

1. access to a mentor during their scholarship term;
2. provision of a practicum placement opportunity for the student, that consist of a half day/full day placement within one of the SA universities or relevant organisation of interest to the student;
3. opportunities to attend HDA events of interest and to receive the bi-monthly HDA newsletter.

Schools are required to nominate students for the scholarship by 5 pm on Tuesday 14 December, which includes a:

- written statement (1,000 word maximum) from the student describing their study and career goals, and identifying how the scholarship will facilitate their achieving these goals; and,
- one-page statement from the school in support of the applicant, including information about the applicant's attendance in Year 10 and their academic progress to date.

The submissions will be assessed by the HDA Executive Committee and successful students and their schools will be notified in January/February 2022.
