

Dear Parent/Carer

Re: COVID-19 at Norwood International High School

I wish to inform you that a member of the Norwood International High School community has tested positive to COVID-19. Your child has been identified as a classroom contact of this case from the Connect class on Wednesday 2 February, Lesson 1 (8:55am), Lesson 2 (9:40am) and Lesson 3 (10:25am).

At this stage your child should continue to attend school, however you must monitor for symptoms for 14 days. I also wish to remind you that as parent/carers, you are responsible for ensuring your child is well and has no symptoms of COVID-19 (even mild) prior to them attending school each day.

For the following 7 full days after Friday 4 February, your child will not be able to attend extracurricular activities at school.

For the next 14 full days your child should also:

- wear a surgical mask around others and outside your home
- avoid COVID-19 Management Plan events
- avoid high-risk settings (e.g. aged care, disability care, healthcare)
- avoid non-essential activities with high transmission risk (e.g., many people, inside, in close contact)
- avoid contact with vulnerable people (elderly, pregnant women, people with chronic health problems) unless it is your immediate family
- avoid shared spaces and maintain physical distancing, where possible.

In the event that your child develops symptoms such as a fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting or extreme tiredness, please:

- obtain a PCR test
- keep your child at home until you receive confirmation of a negative test and their symptoms have resolved, whichever is longer.

If your child tests positive to COVID, he/she must remain isolated for 10 days and must follow SA Health instructions. Please contact the school if this is the case.
